Experience the power of water on your excursion into the Zillertal Alps. The approximately 13 km long Schlegeis Alpine Road leads along waterfalls and natural stone tunnels to the emerald green Schlegeis reservoir. The ideal starting point for a hike with a cozy stop at the surrounding

huts. Learn interesting facts about hydroelectric power generation on a guided tour of the power station and the 131 m high Schlegeis dam wall. Enjoy the unique panorama of glaciers and mountains. We look forward to seeing you.

Modules A and B as well as the gastronomy are only offered during the operating times of the Schlegeis Alpenstraße (mid-May to the end of October). Exception: Module C (info tour at the Mayrhofen power station) can be booked all year round.

Transfer and waiting times to and from the excursion destination and any additional time spent on site are not included. Module A Schlegeis Alpine Road

The toll road takes you around thirteen kilometers high up into the Zillertal mountains. The Schlegeis reservoir is characterized by a breathtaking panorama of the surrounding mountains.

Module C Info tour

Visit the Mayrhofen power station with your personal guide. The perfect opportunity to learn interesting facts about one of the most powerful power plants in Austria.

Module B Dam wall tour

Discover the inside of the 137-metre-high Schlegeis dam wall with a guide. A unique look behind the scenes of hydropower. Please note that the tour is not barrier-free.

Arrival

The Zillertal vacation region can be reached via the main traffic routes from all directions.

Mayrhofen:

Follow the B169 from the Mayrhofen town entrance. After approx. 2.3 kilometers you will reach the Mayrhofen power plant, the meeting point for the power plant tours.

Directions to the Schlegeis reservoir:

Note: From Ginzling there is a height limit of 3.60 m and a length limit of 13 m for all buses.

From Mayrhofen, drive around 15 km along the B169 Zillertal road in the direction of Ginzling and then to the Breitlahner toll station. From the Breitlahner toll station, follow the Schlegeis Alpenstraße for approx. 7 km to the Schlegeis reservoir.
