Modules A, B, C, E, F are only offered during the operating times of the Kaprun high mountain reservoirs (end of May to mid-October). Exception: Module D (info tour in the main power station) can be booked all year round.

Please note that the minimum time requirement only refers to the respective module and is only a guideline for planning purposes. Transfer and waiting times to and from the excursion destination and any additional time spent on site are not taken into account. For modules E and F (catering), the time, the number of people and the choice of dishes will be agreed with you in advance. We will be happy to assist you with the planning and prepare an offer tailored to your interests and time frame.

Module A Ascent and descent

Europe's largest open inclined elevator and transfer buses take you up to 2,040 m above sea level to the Mooserboden reservoir.

Module C Power plant tour

Visit the main power station in Kaprun and the inside of the dam wall at Mooserboden with your personal guide.

Module B Dam wall tour

Discover the inside of the 107 meter high dam wall at Mooserboden with a guide.

Module D Info tour

At the Hauptstufe power station in Kaprun, you can learn interesting facts about electricity generation from hydropower all year round.

Culinary offers

The Mooserboden mountain restaurant offers regional cuisine and plenty of space. The sun terrace invites you to take a relaxing break with a view of the surrounding three thousand meter peaks.

Module E Gastronomy - Lunch menu

Combine your excursion to the Mooserboden reservoir with lunch in the mountain restaurant. The 2-course menu consists of soup and main course, excluding drinks.

Module F Gastronomy - Coffee and cake

Enjoy a cozy coffee break in the mountain restaurant with a coffee specialty of your choice and a a piece of cake.

Arrival

The Zell am See-Kaprun vacation region can be reached via all main traffic routes: Coming from the north via the German highway A9 via Munich, from the east via the Westautobahn A1, from the south via the Tauernautobahn A10 and from the west via the A12 Inntalautobahn via Wörgl.

From Kaprun:

From the Kaprun bypass (traffic circle), follow the signs in the direction of Kitzsteinhorn and reservoirs. After approx. 2.5 kilometers you will reach the Kaprun main stage power station, the starting point for the power station tours.

Directions to the reservoirs:

Following the Kesselfallstraße for approx. 6 kilometers, you will reach the Kassa Kesselfall at the end of the public road, the starting point for the further transfer to the Kaprun high mountain reservoirs. Please note: It is not possible to drive up to the reservoirs in your own bus.
